Although all tuition and fees are due and payable upon entry, a Payment Plan can be developed. The Payment Plan will take into consideration all financial aid and loans for which the student has applied. That portion of the total program which is not covered by financial aid or loans can be pro-rated over the length of the program. Acceptable forms of payment include the following: Visa, Mastercard, American Express, and Discover credit and debit cards; personal checks, cashier's checks, money orders and cash.

Coyne College participates in CTA's UPASS Program. All students must get a UPASS Card while attending Coyne College. The cost of the UPASS Card is \$48.75 for each 6 week term for the Day Students and \$67.50 for each 8 week term for Evening Students. Enrolled students that are out-of state residents are exempt from the fee with proof of residency. Coyne College charges a Technology Fee of \$15.00 per term for each student. A term is defined as 6 weeks for a Day Student and 8 weeks for an Evening Student. The Technology Fee covers part of the cost of software used in the programs as well as Wi-Fi, and other internet costs.

Tuition & Fees are based upon continuous enrollment with successful academic progress.

Page 17, EST110 Low-Voltage Cabling Credits: 3.5
