

Survivor's Rights: For Students Who Have Experienced Sexual Misconduct

If you have been the victim of sexual misconduct, the Coyne College community is here to help you and guide you to the resources that you need. You don't have to go through this alone.

If you have experienced sexual misconduct at the hands of a fellow student, a Coyne employee, or the incident was committed on Coyne College grounds, you have the right:

To report an incident of sexual misconduct to Coyne College

O You can report to the Title IX Coordinator, April London. You may do so in person, by email at alondon@coynecollege.edu or by phone at 773.577.8051.

• To report an incident of sexual misconduct to law enforcement professionals

- o Call 911 in order to report an incident of sexual misconduct to the Chicago Police Department.
- Coyne's Title IX Coordinator can assist you with notifying the Chicago Police Department

To request anonymity when filing your report of sexual misconduct with Coyne College

- If you prefer, we can maintain your anonymity when investigating your claims of sexual misconduct. However, if you remain anonymous, it may limit our ability to investigate the matter fully.
- Please know that if you forego anonymity, Coyne College will do its best to maintain your privacy, sharing your identity only as necessary.

• To request interim measures to protect your safety and well-being, including:

- o Changes to your class schedule, where possible
- o Changes to your Coyne College work schedule, if applicable
- o An escort while on campus

• To be protected from retaliation

- Your privacy and identity will be protected as much as possible while an investigation is conducted.
- Once an incident of misconduct is reported, all parties involved are issued a no-contact directive.
 You and the accused are not allowed to communicate with each other in person, by email, by text,
 by phone conversation or through communication through another party or method.
- If you feel targeted, threatened or in any way retaliated against for reporting misconduct, notify the Title IX Coordinator immediately. Retaliation against any party of the investigation will not be tolerated.
